RCW presents the 180 hour Modular Education Program for Activity Professionals as one continuous program divided into five 36-hour sessions:

Blocks Scheduled:

Block I March 24-27, 2010

Block IV Nov. 3-6, 2010

Block V Jan. 26-29, 2011

Participants can complete the entire course in one year or divide the course (first 3 blocks one year, last 2 blocks the following year) into 2 years.

RCW instructors will help students who have completed previous blocks determine what they need to complete to successfully finish the 180-hour course. The entire course needs to be completed in 3 years or the student will be required to start the entire course over.
